

Machane TBA Primary (Grades PreK-2)

Our youngest students at Machane experience a broad introduction to Jewish life by exploring Jewish holidays and values, Hebrew and tefillah (prayer). Guided by our skilled teachers and clergy, Primary students learn about the importance of tzedakah (charitable giving) and tikkun olam (repairing the world). They also discover the significance of Bible stories and synagogue rituals.

Primary students enjoy instruction in Jewish art, music and movement and engage with our clergy during “Ask the Rabbi” sessions. They participate in large scale programs by grade, such as the Gan (kindergarten) Jonah and the Whale reenactment, Alef (1st grade) Noah’s Arkade and the Bet (2nd grade) Family Passover Seder.
