## **UTCA STATEMENT ON SIGNING OF INFRASTRUCTURE LEGISLATION INTO LAW**

**Farmingdale** – Utility and Transportation Contractors Association (UTCA) CEO Robert Briant, Jr., issued the following statement today on President Biden signing into law bipartisan infrastructure legislation which provides historic levels of investment in the country's infrastructure:

*"We have waited a long time to get here. Infrastructure investment on a scale like this has not been seen in our country in generations. This bipartisan legislation will be viewed as akin to the Highway Act of the 1950s: a transformational moment that means safer more reliable roads, bridges and water infrastructure while creating thousands of good paying jobs. Every member of Congress – including New Jersey's entire delegation – who voted for this bill deserves praise, as does President Biden for advocating for it."*
