



Dr. Katherine Napalinga is a child and adolescent psychiatrist in Reading, PA. Dr. Napalinga completed a fellowship in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at the Drexel University/Hahnemann University Child and Adolescent Psychiatry program and a residency in Psychiatry at the Einstein Medical Center Philadelphia program, building a robust background in managing autism spectrum disorders, ADHD, mood disorders, and PTSD.
