Dr. Bristol was born in Guyana, South America and immigrated to Brooklyn, NY with his family as a teenager. He earned a BA from Cornell University, an MD from the Albany Medical College (AMC), and an MPH from the University at Albany School of Public Health. He completed a General Pediatric Internship & Residency at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. He returned to Albany, NY and worked as an Academic General Pediatrician and was a member of the AMC faculty for 13 years. Dr. Bristol relocated to China for 5 years where he completed a physician leadership sabbatical as Chief Medical Officer of Shanghai United Family Healthcare. During this time, he became a Certified Physician Executive (CPE). Dr. Bristol repatriated and continued his academic/leadership career, joining the CHS-Levine Children's Hospital in Charlotte, NC as part of the UNC Faculty, and subsequently UNC Healthcare in Chapel Hill as a Professor of Pediatrics/Medical Director.

Insufficient access to psychiatrists motivated Dr. Bristol to take a leave from Academic General Pediatrics to complete the Post Pediatric Portal Program Psychiatry Fellowship at the Medical College of Georgia/Augusta University in 2020-2022. Dr. Bristol joined the Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health Physicians Departments of Behavioral Health Specialists and General Pediatrics in 2023. He is Board Certified in General Pediatrics, General and Child/Adolescent Psychiatry. Dr. Bristol's interests include Behavioral Health, Culturally Competent Healthcare, Healthcare Disparities, Population Health, Healthcare Administration, Adolescent Medicine, and Lead Poisoning.
