



Howie Levin, M.D. is a board-certified child psychiatrist at St. Luke's University Health Network (SLUHN), where he serves as Vice Chair of the Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Health. Dr. Levin was recently named as a distinguished fellow of the American Psychiatric Association and of the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.
