

# Gingerbread House Competition Guidelines



## Rules for Entry

1. Entrants will be placed in one of three categories: **K-5th, 6-8th, and Adult/Child**.  
*\*Note: Group entries will be placed in the K-5, 6-8 or Adult/Child division according to the oldest member of the group.*
2. Group participation and individual entries are welcome.  
*\*Note: The display board does not have to be made of edible materials.*
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per participant, but **each entry will be charged the \$6.00 entry fee payable through this [online form](#)**.
4. Gingerbread creations must be built upon a sturdy display board with a maximum 15" width and 16" depth.  
*\*Note: The display board does not have to be made of edible materials.*
5. All gingerbread creations must be made entirely of edible materials; i.e. no wood, cardboard, wire, lights etc. may be used or incorporated into the structure to be eligible for judging.  
*\*Note: The gingerbread creation does not have to be a house. The creation can be any structure or design as long as it incorporates gingerbread.*
6. Contest Timeline:  
Contest begins: **Monday, November 16<sup>th</sup>**  
Submissions due: **Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup>**  
Contest judging: **Monday, December 7<sup>th</sup>**  
Winners announced: **Thursday, December 10<sup>th</sup>**
7. All gingerbread creations will be submitted virtually via this [SA Gingerbread House Flipgrid](#). You will have 2 minutes to introduce us to your structure from all angles!
8. Entries may not be awarded more than one prize.
9. One entry from each division will be awarded a prize based on creativity and presentation.

## Prizes for Winners

- All participating students will receive a dress down day pass.
- Winners of all divisions will be announced in “The Connection”, school announcements, and on Instagram and Facebook. Prizes will be available for pickup starting December 11.
