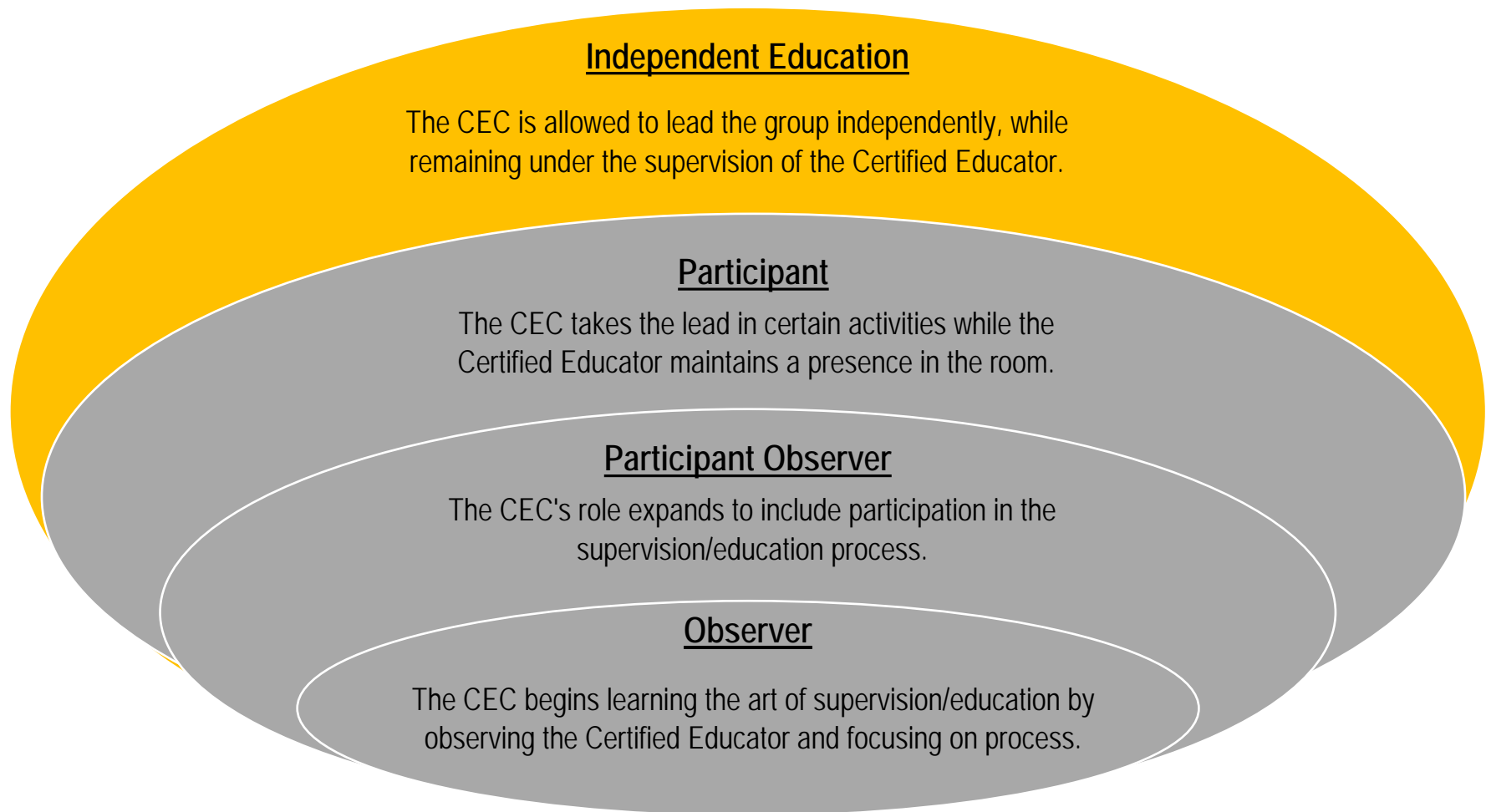


Progressive Autonomy in Educating Under Supervision

Phase I of the New Certification Process includes the acquisition of knowledge and emerging demonstration of competence. As such, the CEC engages in supervision and education alongside the training educator, with progressive autonomy in certain areas. During **Phase I**, the Certified Educator who is supervising a CEC must have a live presence in the room with the ability to intervene if necessary. This may be an in-room presence or a two-way video conferencing presence when there is geographic distance between the Certified Educator and the CEC.

Phase II of the New Certification Process includes integrative work and the demonstration of increasing competence and independence. It is in **Phase II** that a CEC is allowed to supervise without the Certified Educator having a presence in the room.



In all cases, the ACPE Certified Educator is responsible for both the CEC and the students with whom the CEC is working.
