Please continue to work with your Community Impact Coordinator or Property Manager on any rent-related issues.
- We know how isolated and stressful residents can become during the shelter-in-home orders, so our staff is equipped to perform wellness checks for those residents in need.
- We created the website <https://poah.auntbertha.com/>, so that residents can be connected to local resources related to financial support, education, health, housing, and community engagement. You can also find out where and how to take advantage of flu testing in your area.

We are all in this together. And our residents help us play an important part in slowing the spread of this virus. Residents should continue to refer to the guidelines we have provided on interactions and social distancing. We ask residents to also limit access in their apartments to all outside visitors (except for caregivers, families or health/essential service-related personnel).

Finally, residents can continue to make appointments with the property management team so that we can prepare and address your issues/concerns in a timely manner.
