

# Snowflake Showcase Cards



## 1. Hello Friend Color-Blocking card

1. Texture the three colors of card stock with the embossing folders. Adhere to the main White card.
2. Ink the medallion image in Grapefruit ink and stamp on the White card stock. Ink the 6-sided leaf like image in Mint Macaron ink and stamp over the first image. Die-cut with the largest Circle in the framelits. Adhere to the card with dimensionals.
3. Ink the greeting in Mint Macaron ink and stamp on a scrap of White. Punch out with the 1" circle punch. Sponge the edge with Grapefruit Grove ink. Adhere to a Mint 1 1/8" scalloped circle punched piece with dimensionals. Add to the medallion.
4. Add a few Faceted Dots as desired.
5. Finish with a Grapefruit ribbon bow, added with a glue dot.

Ink: Grapefruit Grove, Mint Macaron

## 2. Polka Dot Fun-Fold card

1. Ink the medallion image in Daffodil Delight ink and stamp three times on the White square of card stock. Adhere to the Daffodil Square and then to the front of the White folded card.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the Daffodil Delight panel as shown in the photos.
3. Adhere the folded White card to the inside of the Daffodil card leaving enough room for your polka dot ribbon to be wrapped around and tied into a knot. Add a mini glue dot to the knot to hold it in place.
4. Ink the greeting in Daffodil Delight ink and stamp in the center of the strip. Add to the stamped layer.
5. Die-cut a solid flower from the designer paper. Also die-cut a detailed flower from White card stock. Adhere to the stamped medallion with dimensionals. Add an Epoxy droplet to the center.

### 3. Floral Friend card

1. Ink the solid leaf image in Mossy Meadow ink and stamping off first, stamp all around the outside edge of the Mossy Meadow card stock. Adhere it to just the left panel of the main Vanilla card.
2. Punch or trim the Vanilla strip into banner ends. Adhere to the card front.
3. Ink the lined flower image in Mossy Meadow ink and stamp off once before stamping on Vanilla card stock. Die-cut with the solid flower die.
4. Ink the border image in Mossy Meadow ink and stamp on the bottom of the Vanilla CS.
5. Add the greeting 2/3" above that in Blackberry Bliss ink. Adhere to the Blackberry Bliss layer.
6. Wrap a length of Nature's twine around this and tie into a knot on the front left.
7. Die-cut two Mossy Meadow 'leaves' and one detailed flower from Blackberry Bliss card stock. Assemble these pieces together and add with a dimensional. Add a pearl to the center.
8. Stamp the inside as shown.

## 4. It's Your Day Floral card

1. Ink the small solid flower in Gorgeous Grape ink and stamp onto scraps of White card stock 7 times. Die-cut with the coordinating framelit.
2. Die-cut one swirl of snowflakes from the Old Olive panel. Adhere the flowers to the olive swirl and add to the Designer paper with dimensionals.
3. Adhere that to the Olive card stock and then to the main card.
4. Add a punched Olive Tailored Tag to the bottom of the designer paper. Wrap the Grape ribbon around the card securing the ends on top of the Tag punch.
5. Ink the greeting and stamp on a scrap of White. Punch out with a 1 ¼" circle punch.
6. Punch out a 1 ¾" Grape circle, a 1 ½" Olive circle. Add these together and top it you're your greeting circle. Add to cover the ribbon ends with dimensionals.
7. Finish by adding Glittered Enamel dots to each flower.

## 5. Fun Oval Floral card

1. Ink the small solid flower in Lemon Lime ink and stamp on a small scrap of White. Die-cut it out with the coordinating die.
2. Also die-cut two detailed flowers from Bermuda Bay card stock and one solid flower from Pool Party card stock. Adhere these together as shown with a dimensional under the small flower. Add a folded flag of ribbon to the back with mini glue dots.
3. Die-cut the two ovals from White card stock. Position three of the Oval framelits onto your White CS. I used the 2", the 2 ½" and 3" wide oval dies. You'll have one extra 'frame' you will not use left over.
4. Ink the greetings in Bermuda Bay ink and stamp as shown.
5. Ink the solid leaves in Lemon Lime ink and stamp off once before stamping twice as shown.
6. Adhere the White oval frame to the Black CS. Add the Lemon Lime strip across that. Adhere to the main card.
7. Add the stamped White oval with dimensionals. Add the layered flower to the left side.

## 6. New Beginnings card

1. Ink the small solid flower and the striped flower in Fresh Fig ink and stamp on a scrap of White CS. Die-cut both of them out. Also die-cut a detailed flower and two White berry like die-cuts. Layer these together with dimensionals.
2. Adhere the thin strip of designer paper to the smallest White CS layer. Ink the greeting in Fresh Fig ink and stamp above it and to the left.
3. Adhere the Fresh Fig designer paper to the left flap of the main White card. Adhere the other layers onto that (check the lower left photo so you can see how the card opens)
4. Add the layered flower and a knot of ribbon with a glue dot.
5. Spray the entire card front with a mixture of Champagne shimmer paint and rubbing alcohol with a Stamping Spritzer.

## 7. Congratulations Diagonal card

1. Adhere the designer paper piece to the left side of the main card. Add a strip of White card stock to that and trim the excess ends off.
2. Ink the greeting in Smoky Slate ink and stamp on the upper right of the Blushing Bride main card.
3. Ink the flowers in Smoky Slate and Blushing Bride ink and stamp on scraps of Blushing Bride and White card stock. You need three layers for each flower. Die-cut with the coordinating framelits.
4. Die-cut 5 detailed leaves from Silver Foil paper.
5. Assemble the flowers and leaves. Add a Frosted or Clear Epoxy droplet to each one. Adhere to the diagonal area of the card as shown.

## 8. Floral Friend card

1. Ink the greeting in Calypso Coral ink and stamp on a scrap of White CS. Punch out with the 1 ¼" circle punch.
2. Ink the solid flower in Calypso Coral ink and stamp on the Blushing Bride strip. Adhere to the other layers and add pearls to each flower.
3. Adhere the layers to the card as shown, adding dimensionals to the horizontal stamped layer. Finish with a double knot of 1/8" Calypso Coral sheer ribbon added with a mini glue dot.

## 9. Emboss Resist card

1. Ink greeting in Highland Heather ink and stamp on a scrap of White CS. Punch out with a 1 ¼" circle punch. Adhere that to a 1 3/8" scalloped circle Balmy Blue piece.
2. Die-cut a solid flower from Highland Heather card stock and add the greeting with dimensionals.
3. Texture the Highland Heather strip with the embossing folder. Add to the card.
4. Swipe the embossing buddy over the smaller White card stock layer. Ink the medallion image in Versamark ink and stamp multiple times. Heat emboss using either White or Clear embossing powder.
5. Use sponges to rub Balmy Blue and Highland Heather ink over the embossed card stock. Wipe excess ink off with a tissue or paper towel.
6. Use the Detailed Trio punch to round the outer two corners. Adhere to the card.
7. Cut or punch a banner end in the Balmy Blue strip. Adhere.
8. Add the greeting layer. Finish with a polka dot bow added with a mini glue dot.

## 10. It's Your Day Medallion Fun-Fold card

1. Ink the medallion image in Real Red ink and stamp on the white square of card stock. Die-cut with a 2 7/8" circle framelit. Die-cut a 3" scalloped circle from Olive card stock. Adhere these together.
2. Ink the greeting in Real Red ink and stamp on a scrap of White CS. Punch out with a 1 1/4" circle punch. Adhere that to a Real Red 1 3/8" scallop circle punched piece. Add to the center of the stamped medallion with dimensionals.
3. Ink the solid leaves in Old Olive ink and stamp around the outer edge of the Olive card stock. Texture with the embossing folder.
4. Add the Real Red layer and then the Olive banner piece.
5. Adhere the layered medallion over it all.
6. Note how the card opens. Adhere the upper area of the Olive layer to the upper flap of the Real Red card using dimensionals.
7. Stamp the inside as shown.

## 11. Wood Textures card

1. Ink the blizzard image in Grape ink and stamp on the Gorgeous Grape strip repeatedly. Adhere to the White card.
2. Swipe the embossing buddy over the Heather card stock. Ink the greeting in Versamark and stamp on the lower middle. Heat emboss using White embossing powder. Adhere to the White card.
3. Die-cut three snowflakes and the connected snowflake swirl image from scraps of White card stock. Adhere using Fine Tip glue or Multipurpose adhesive.
4. Add rhinestones.
5. Tie a bow from Polka Dot tulle ribbon and add with a mini glue dot.

## 12. Christmas Holly card

1. Ink the snowflakes in Bermuda Bay ink and stamp on the right edge of the large Pool Party card stock. Adhere to the main card.
2. Ink the Buffalo Check stamp in Bermuda Bay ink. Stamp onto the Pool Party card stock (best to either use the Stamparatus or the 'upside down' method to get the best image) Adhere to the Bermuda Bay layer and then to the main card.
3. Ink the greeting in Bermuda Bay ink and stamp on the right end of the Pool Party 1" strip. Cut or punch into a banner end.
4. Wrap the striped ribbon around it and tie it into a knot. Adhere this piece to the card with dimensionals along with the White strip too.
5. Die-cut a White snowflake and one connected swirl of snowflakes. Adhere to the card as shown with mini glue dots or dimensionals.
6. Color your rhinestones with a Bermuda Bay marker. Let set to dry a bit. Add to the snowflakes.
7. Spray the entire card with a mixture of Champagne Shimmer paint and rubbing alcohol using a Stamin' Spritzer.

### 13. Navy & Silver Snowflake card

1. Use the Precision plate to die-cut the large snowflake from White card stock. Also cut out one medium Silver glimmer and three small Silver Glimmer snowflakes. The precision plate makes this so much easier!
2. Adhere the medium Silver snowflake to the large White snowflake in the center. Adhere to the Night of Navy card stock. Add the three small snowflakes as shown. Add to the large White card stock.
3. Ink the greeting in Navy ink and stamp on the White banner. Cut or punch the ends into a banner shape. Add over the center of the snowflakes with dimensionals.
4. Adhere this layer to the front left flap of the fun fold Navy card stock.
5. Stamp the inside as shown. Adhere to the inside of the card.

## 14. Silver & Gray Snowflake card

1. Die-cut the snowflakes from a strip of White card stock. Then use your 1 ½" circle punch to punch out the White circles. Adhere to three Silver foil 1 ¾" circles. Adhere to the White card stock strip. Add Clear Epoxy Droplets to each one.
2. Adhere that to the Smoky Slate card stock.
3. Ink the dotted stamp image in Smoky Slate ink and stamp on the outer edges of the card front. Adhere the layered layer to this piece.
4. Wrap the ribbon around the entire front and tie into an overhand knot.
5. Ink the greeting in Smoky Slate ink and stamp on a ½" X 2" piece of Smoky Slate card stock. Cut the ends into a banner shape with your paper snips. Adhere as shown.
6. Stamp the inside as desired.

## 15. Christmas Tree Easel card

1. Ink the greeting in Cherry Cobbler ink and stamp on a scrap of White card stock. Punch out with the 1 3/8" scalloped circle punch. Adhere that to a 1 1/2" Black circle punch.
2. Die-cut an outline flower from Cherry Cobbler card stock. Adhere the greeting layer to it with dimensionals.
3. Swipe the embossing buddy over your Black card stock. Ink the tree in Versamark and stamp onto the CS. Heat emboss with White embossing powder. Adhere to the Cherry Cobbler layer. Also add the tree trunk image and heat emboss in White.
4. Ink the dotted image in Versamark ink and stamp on the Cherry Cobbler card stock strip. Adhere to the front flap of the White easel card.
5. Adhere the layered tree image to this, centering it on the front of the card as it's laying flat.
6. Ink the snowflakes in Cherry Cobbler ink and stamp on the inside bottom of the card. Add your layered greeting with Dimensionals about 1/2" from the bottom. This holds the tree into an easel.
7. Add a twine bow and Red rhinestones.

## 16. Joyful Snowflakes card

1. Ink the greeting in Merry Merlot ink and stamp on the bottom right corner of the Sahara Sand card stock. Adhere the designer paper and Copper foil strips as shown. Add to the main card.
2. Die-cut one White snowflake and one small Copper foil snowflake using the Precision plate. Adhere to the card as shown.
3. Add a rhinestone to the center of the foil snowflake.

Sahara Sand 3 ¾" X 5"

Joyous Noel designer paper 2" X 5"

Copper foil strips ¼" X 5"

Precision base plate, Big Shot, rhinestone jewels, Dimensionals

Ink: Merry Merlot

## 17. Triple Fold card

1. Ink the snowflake images in White craft ink and stamp on the top flap of the Basic Gray card. Set aside to dry or heat set with a heat tool.
2. Die-cut three snowflakes; two from Silver foil paper and one from Black card stock.
3. Punch out a 1 3/4" White circle and a 2" Basic Gray circle. Layer these together and add the two larger snowflakes to it. Add a rhinestone to the center.
4. With the top flap down and the bottom flap lowered, insert the 2" circle punch over the top and punch once so you get 1/2 of a circle through both layers.
5. Stamp the White inside as shown using Basic Gray ink, stamping off once for the snowflakes if desired. Adhere to the inside of the card. Insert the same 2" circle punch over this and punch it again to match the first one.
6. Add the layered snowflake circles to the card stock matching the opening of the front.
7. Texture the White Velvet paper with the embossing folder. Adhere it to the front flap.
8. Ink the greeting in Basic Gray ink and stamp on a 1 1/8" White card stock strip. Use the Everyday Label punch to punch both ends as shown below. Adhere this to a Black strip and use the punch again; adding 1/8" to each side. Add to the card with dimensionals.
9. Adhere the small snowflake with a dimensional and adhere a ribbon know with a mini glue dot.

## 18. Softly Falling Joy

1. Texture the Sahara Sand card stock. Adhere to the main card with dimensionals.
2. Punch or cut the ends of the Silver foil layer into banner shape. Adhere as shown.
3. Ink the snowflakes in Sahara Sand and Pool Party ink and stamp on your White card stock as shown. Adhere to the Sahara Sand layer.
4. Punch out a Pool Party Tailored Tag punch. Add Tear and Tape or mini glue dots to the fold of ribbon and adhere it to the punched piece.
5. Ink the greeting in Pool Party ink and stamp on a scrap of White card stock. Punch out with the 1 3/8" scalloped circle punch. Sponge the edge with Pool Party ink and add over the ribbon with dimensionals.
6. Add a Snowflake Trinket with a mini dimensional.

## 19. Frosted Block Technique

1. To create this beautiful swirly background, ink a clear block in Blueberry Bushel ink (I used a D block). Add a bit of shaving cream (a Tablespoon or so) and spread it over the inked block with a plastic knife. Then smooch it all over the White card stock. Let dry. Cut off ¼" from one long end; set aside.
2. Die-cut one large snowflake from Blueberry card stock using the Precision base plate and your Big Shot. Also die-cut one small White snowflake. Adhere these together and add a Clear Epoxy droplet.
3. Stamp snowflakes using Blueberry ink all over the Frosted Block technique layer.
4. Adhere this layer to the White card stock and then to the main Blueberry card.
5. Ink the greeting in Blueberry ink and stamp on a scrap of White CS. Punch out with the Everyday Label punch. You just need the lower edge of this piece so trim it in half.
6. Adhere the ¼" strip to the Blueberry strip and then to the main card, tucking the greeting piece under the left lower edge.
7. Adhere the snowflakes with a dimensional or two under the center.
8. Stamp the inside as desired.





## 20. Gold & Spruce Tree card

1. Ink the large tree in Shaded Spruce ink and stamp on a scrap of Shaded Spruce card stock. Cut this out by hand. Add gold metallic pearls to it.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the left front panel.
3. Stamp snowflakes in Shaded Spruce ink on the upper part of the White card stock layer. Adhere the tree with dimensionals.
4. Add a piece of Wood Textures designer paper for the trunk.
5. Punch out some Gold foil stars using the Twinkle builder punch. Adhere with Multipurpose glue or mini glue dots.
6. Adhere all layers as shown and add to the front left flap of the card.
7. Stamp your greeting and cut it at an angle before adding to the card with dimensionals.
8. Add a double knot of Old Olive ribbon with a mini glue dot.
9. Spray the entire card front with a Champagne shimmer paint/rubbing alcohol mixture using the Stampin' Spritzers.
10. Stamp the inside as shown.

Shaded Spruce 5 1/2" X 6 1/2" scored at 4 1/4" plus 2 3/4" X 4 3/4" and an extra piece for the tree

Under the Mistletoe designer paper 2" X 5 1/4"

Old Olive 3" X 5"

Whisper White 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" plus 4" X 5 1/4" for inside and 1/2" strip for greeting

Gold foil paper for stars

Wood Textures designer paper 1" X 1/2"
