Since 1987, the Universal Placement Program (UPP) has helped thousands of international students of all educational levels to find and be accepted into excellent colleges and universities in the United States.



Simple application process:

Our application form is used to apply to all schools, making our process faster and easier than other methods. We work in collaboration with the admission team at the institutions to get faster responses.

Conditional admission:

If you need help with English before joining your undergraduate or graduate program, we can help you get conditional admission to most of our partner schools, which will allow you to enter an ESL program with us and then transfer after completion. We can even get admission to a college or university without having to take the mandatory English tests, such as TOEFL or IELTS.


PATHWAYS AT FLS

SAMPLE PATHWAYS-CLASSIC PLAN


Three Step Options



Students begin their educational journey at an FLS center where students will improve their English proficiency and gain the skills needed to succeed in the American academic system. Students who complete Level 14 may then transfer to a community college and complete an Associates' Degree.

Afterwards, students can transfer to a four-year university to complete a Bachelor's Degree.

Two Step Options



Students with strong academic skills may choose to complete a more advanced FLS level (15-18, depending upon school) and transfer directly to a 4-year college or university. Our partner institutions work closely with FLS to ensure that students have a seamless transfer
