## **THE PLAN**

- Provide every Illinois child with access to preschool
- Increase funding to childcare providers to raise wages and quality
- Invest in new early childhood facilities and expand existing locations
- Reach more vulnerable families with early support and resources

## SMART START INVESTMENTS

Smart Start begins with a **\$250 million** investment in early childhood education and care, including:

- \$75 million more for the Early Childhood Block Grant to put Illinois on a path to creating more than 20,000 new Pre-K spots
- \$130 million for nation-leading Child Care Workforce Compensation Contracts that will stabilize providers and give childcare workers a raise
- \$40 million more for Early Intervention
- \$5 million to expand DHS' Home Visiting Program



## **ADDITIONAL INVESTMENTS**



- \$100 million in capital dollars for early childhood providers to expand existing facilities and build new facilities
- \$70 million for Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)
- \$12 million in funding for scholarships and apprenticeships to expand the childcare workforce
- \$1.6 million to launch the Dolly Parton Imagination Library, a statewide literacy initiative to send free books to children from birth-through age five
