

# Don't Risk Losing Your Medicaid Coverage

The State of Illinois is preparing for the end of the nation's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. If you had Medicaid insurance, you were automatically re-enrolled in Medicaid as part of the emergency response. When the Public Health Emergency ends, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services will stop automatically re-enrolling people for Medicaid.

**This means Medicaid members will lose their insurance if they do not re-enroll.**



**Follow these steps to make sure you do not lose your Medicaid health insurance:**

**Visit [medicaid.illinois.gov](https://www.medicaid.illinois.gov) or call (877) 805-5312 to update your contact information.**

The State of Illinois needs your mailing address, phone number and email address to contact you about your Medicaid coverage.

**Check your mail for a letter from the State of Illinois.**

After April 1, the State of Illinois will mail a letter to you about your Medicaid coverage. The letter will let you know if you need to complete a renewal form.

**Complete your renewal form (if you get one).**

If a renewal form is needed, fill out the form and return it to the State of Illinois right away so you do not lose Medicaid insurance.

**If you can no longer get Medicaid, you may be able to get insurance using the Health Insurance Marketplace. This marketplace allows you to get health insurance at a lower price.**
