Updates (<https://pubsearch.lhfmissions.org/>): In Africa, in particular, we are translating the “What About” series from Dr. Barry in the late 1990s. Two years ago, we had a Lutheran pastor in Malawi ask about the abortion article as his nation was considering a more liberal abortion law. Since then, we have been translating many of these topics in the languages of Africa, including Amharic (as you can see from the link provided above).

Pastor Robert Rahn’s Gospel tract Jesus Never Fails, is being shared with Ukrainian medics and soldiers on the front lines of the Ukrainian-Russian war.

A Danish Lutheran theologian, Hans Erik Nissen, put together a good set of devotions for the year, which we have now published in Turkish.

We also utilize CPH’s recent resources, like Matthew Richard’s Will the Real Jesus Please Stand Up? 12 False Christs, now in Latvian! Our Latvian team is also looking for timely books on topics that could open the eyes of post-Christian Europeans.

My First Catechism is also out in Japanese now, a laborious process to get into Japanese, both for those residing in the U.S. as well as Japan.

There are many more, and our Dinku Bato can share about that (as well as Ted NaThalang) at the Multi-Ethnic Conference at Concordia Seminary in early May.
