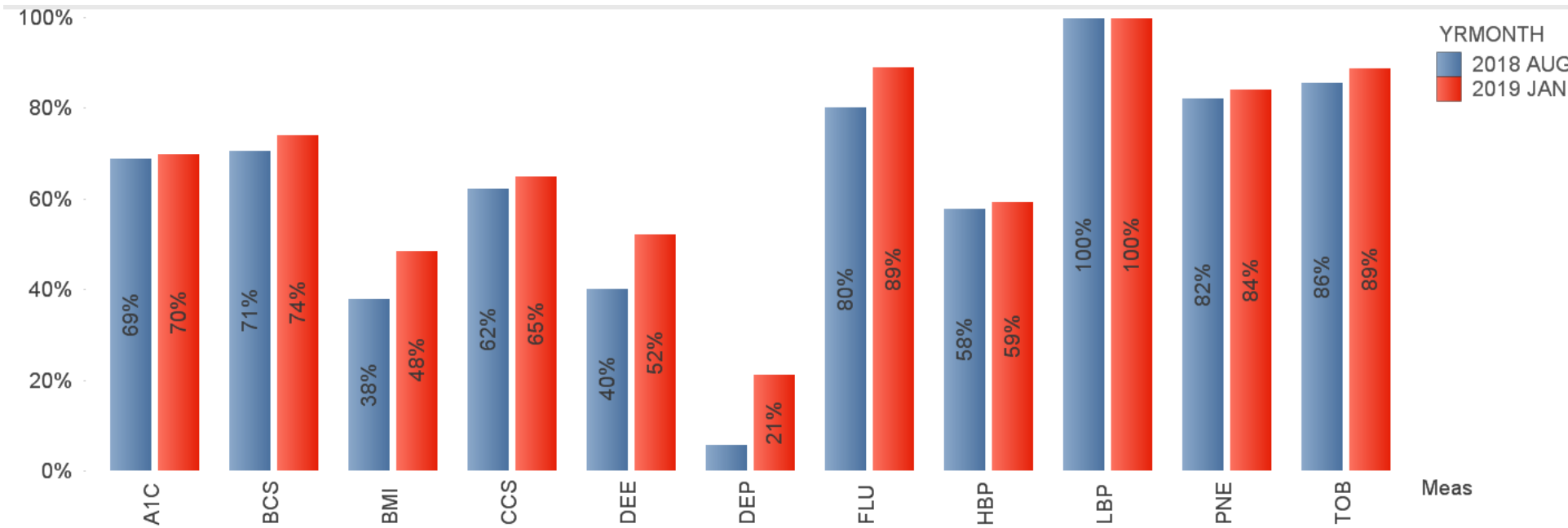


## January 2019 UHA Quality Measures

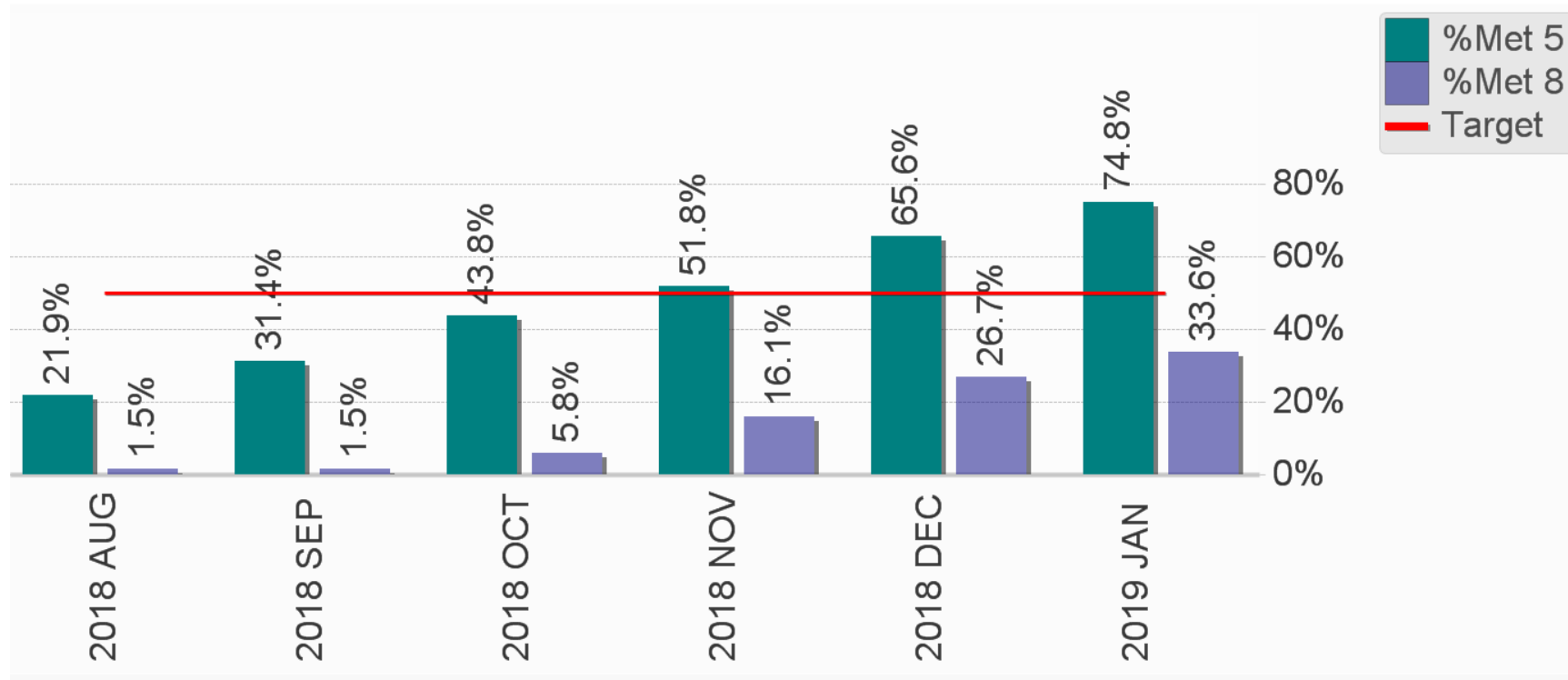
## Measure Performance – All UHA

UHA and Medical Group leadership selected 11 measures from the Healthy Planet dashboard to work on together in 2019. The baseline period for performance was August of 2018 (show in blue) compared to current performance (January 2019). Notable performance from baseline period include improvement on BMI assessment and follow up plan, Diabetes Eye Exam, Depression Screening, and imaging for low back pain.



**Measure Nomenclature:**  
 A1C: Hemoglobin A1C  
 BCS: Breast Cancer Screening  
 BMI: Adult BMI assessment  
 CCS: Colon Cancer Screening  
 DEE: Diabetes Eye Exam  
 DEP: Depression Screening  
 FLU: Flu shot  
 HBP: Hypertension Control  
 LBP: Screening for low back pain  
 PNE: Pneumonia vaccination  
 TOB: Tobacco screening and counseling

## Goal Performance – January 2019 All UHA



The 2019 quality goals have been constructed such that each provider has a target for each of the 11 measures based on their performance during the benchmark period. An example to illustrate is a provider who was doing well on colon cancer screening (80<sup>th</sup> percentile nationally) but not so well on depression screening (10<sup>th</sup> percentile nationally). This providers individual goal for those 2 measures would be to move colon cancer screening to 90<sup>th</sup> and depression screening to 30<sup>th</sup>. The overarching goal for UHA and the medical groups is for 50% of providers to meet targets on 8 or more measures.

# Measure Performance – January 2019 – % All UHA Providers Meeting the Measure

Meas	measure
A1C	Diabetes Composite: Hemoglobin A1C Good Control
BCS	Breast Cancer Screening
BMI	Preventive Care Screening: BMI and Follow Up
CCS	Colorectal Cancer Screening
DEE	Diabetes Composite: Diabetes Eye Exam
DEP	Preventive Care Screening: Screening for Clinical Depression and Follow Up Plan
FLU	Preventive Care Screening: Influenza Vaccine administration
HBP	Controlling High Blood Pressure: High BP (18-59 Yrs)
LBP	Use of Imaging Studies for Low Back Pain
PNE	Pneumonia Vaccination Status for Older Adults
TOB	Preventive Care Screening: Tobacco Use Screening and Intervention

Each measure requires different levels of intervention. This graph shows by measure, the percentage of providers who are meeting targets on the measure.
