For this project, students created a series of fantastical machines based upon direct observational studies of simple forms (cubes, cylinders, spheres, pyramids and cones). Each form was then embellished to become a machine with a specific function. These machines were then placed within an appropriate setting, with the option of utilizing web-based imagery as a visual resource. Finally, each student was asked to write a lyrical description of the machine and its function.

This project supports the following course outcomes for DRAW 101:


- Students will organize the compositional relationship of objects to each other within the picture plane.

- Students will use research (i.e., sketchbooks, quick studies, digital resources) to incorporate process in their drawings.




